



Product Concept: Provide affordable, efficient prosthetic arms inspired by Rishi's journey after losing his right arm at 24.

Deal Status: Secured ₹40 lakh for 1% equity, 1% advisory equity, and ₹40 lakh debt at 10% interest for 3 years from Namita Thapar.







Celebrating Inclusive Creativity.

Founders: Architect Shweta Runwal and her daughters, Dhriti and Ira Ranka.

Product Concept: Creates high-quality lifestyle products, such as stationery, bags, and jewellery, featuring unique designs crafted by artists with Down syndrome.

Deal Status: Received ₹21.3 lakh for 7% equity from Anupam Mittal and Aman Gupta.
